The Foundation attempts to do it through a range of its activities which are – a) Care for All, b) Love Your World, c) Food for Everyone, d) Culture for Development, e) Cli-Mate. As a part of **Care for All**, the foundation is working on elderly care, mental health awareness for children, adults, happiness of terminally ill cancer patients, destitutes, people suffering from diseases and disasters.

As a part of **Care for All**, the foundation is also working for the women empowerment within the destitutes and poor, marginal communities. To illustrate, as a part of Care For All initiatives, more than 4000 people have been benefitted in marginal villages of Bihar through Blanket, Food, Essential Grocery Distribution. Additionally, through sports for development, visually impaired the foundation is taking care of all. Four Blood Donation Camps and Breast Cancer Testing Camps have been conducted by the Foundation with the support of **Rotary International in Faridabad**. **Under the Care For All Domain**, **various initiatives have been led by Mr. Rishi Kapoor**, **Dr. Preeti Singh**, **Mr. Jeevesh Gupta**, **Ms. Pallavi Goyal**.

As a part of Love Your World, the foundation is working with Blooming Tanman on mental health, education and awareness of children. It is focusing on range of initiatives to enhance the happiness quotient of people, children from different strata of the society. Almost more than 6000 children and their lives have been touched upon by Blooming Tanman in a year since its inception. Blooming Tanman has worked with slum kids too and has made an impact in cities of Pune, Chennai and Delhi. The initiative has been led by Mrs. Sagarika Banerjee and Mrs. Malavika Joshi.

For the **Food For Everyone initiative**, 2000 hungry children and their food have been taken care of consistently by the Foundation in the last one year. Additionally, the foundation has reached far flung villages of Bihar regularly and working with communities regularly.

In the **Culture For Development Initiative**, Cultural Policy Chaupal has been conducted with the support of **Ministry of Culture**, **Indira Gandhi National Centre For Arts**.

Additionally, a collaboration with Centre for Public Policy and Governance has been established to implement the **Cultural Policy Chaupal which was coordinated by Mrs. Vanita Pathak from the Foundation.** In collaboration with **Tagbin**, cultural story telling has been done communicating the art, culture and heritage traditions of Indian Villages as a part of the Government of India's Mera Gao Mera Dharohar Scheme. A song called "Fanaa" was created by the band **Justajoo and supported by TOHRI Foundation in collaboration with Mr. Rishi Khanna from Tri Master International. Under this domain, the foundation is soon launching a journal focusing on art, culture, humanities and sustainability being led by Dr. Durairaj Kumarasamy**.

Within Cli-Mate, the foundation partnered with The POP Movement and supported the POP Festival during February 2024 in New Delhi with international, national participants and youth representatives. Further, the foundation with the support of Shri Anil Sood has created tree plantation in a place called Bobas in Rajasthan. The foundation reached out to the climate disaster impacted flood affected regions of Ghatal, Pashkura with the support of Ms. Piyal Banerjee.
